1. RESUME

- (1) In the "Education" column, please list all education since high school graduation. If you are a graduate student, please list your main courses of study.
- (2) In the "Work (Professional) Experience" column, please list the title of the position, the name of the department, research division, and medical department of the applicant's affiliation.
- (3) For overseas study, please state the period, name of the host institution, and title of position, etc.
- (4) For academic activities, please provide the name of the academic society and position, etc., to which you belong.
- (5) All dates should be listed in Western calendar year.

2. List of Research Achievements

- (1) If you have obtained an ORCID ID, please list it in the box below your name.
- (2) Please list in chronological order from the earliest year of publication, with numbers 1, 2, 3, ..., for each category such as English original, Japanese original,
- (3) For paper presentation, those that have been peer-reviewed should be listed. In addition, the title of the article or book, author(s), journal name, volume, first and last page, year of publication (A.D.), and for original works, review articles, and case reports, the most recent impact factor (IF) and citation count (CI) should be listed. As long as these items are listed, there is no problem with rearranging the order of the items or adding additional items as necessary.
- (4) If there are names of co-authors, please enter their names in the order listed and underline their names. Responsible authors should be marked with an asterisk (*).
- (5) Please exclude items that are in the process of being submitted. For items scheduled for publication or in print, please attach a letter of decision from the publisher.
- (6) Please circle the number of the major paper reprints (no more than 10) you are submitting, and also indicate the number on the paper reprints.

(7) Please mark the number of the dissertation with a ©.

(8) For h-index, please include the search source (Scopus, Web of Science, etc.).
